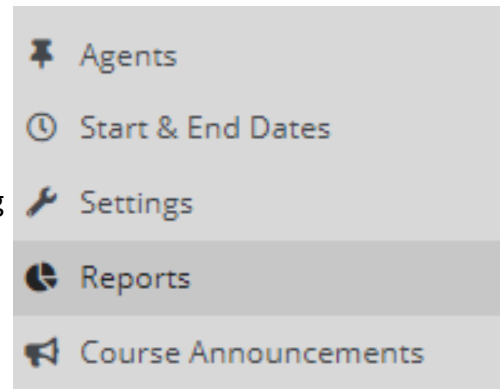


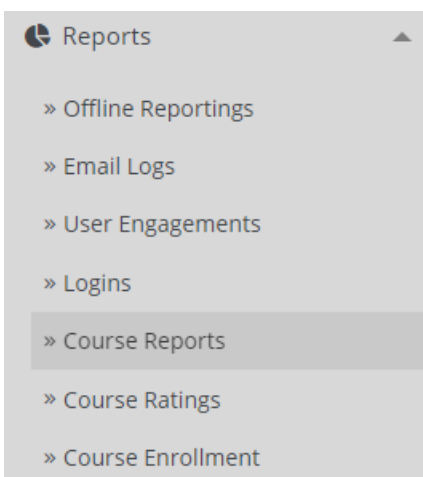
From the **Course** page, click on **Reports**.

Track learner data individually or for all students enrolled in a course to allow the monitoring of compliance with and assessment of the learning environment. Course reports include a downloadable onscreen graph and/or Excel/PDF export option.



The following reports are commonly used:

- **Course Logins & Page Views**—shows when a student was active and what was accessed within the course. Shows page URL and date visited for each student
- **Time Taken on Tests**—shows the amount of time a student spent taking a test along with the start time and end time.
- **Time Taken on Lessons**—shows the sum of the time in minutes from when a student first visits a lesson item to the time the student marks that lesson item complete
- **Test Stats**—comprehensive test statistics including final scores by student, overall test stats such as average and median scores, percentages of students who answered each question correctly, distractor analysis, and a discrimination index. Allows for the identification of competency issues.
- **Test Detail**—test scores by student and a listing of which questions were answered correctly by students. Allows for the identification of knowledge gaps
- **SCORM Report**—STAR courses use SCORM video files. View the start time, end time, and total elapsed time by student and SCORM file to ensure that students are completing course material.
- **Course Completion**—view quick completion information by student as to whether the course is completed, the completion date (if application) and the progress percentage.



Admins can run course reports on multiple courses at the same time by going to the Home page and then selecting Reports → Course Reports from the left hand navigation. Use the select courses button to select multiple courses (including courses from different terms).
