


Your Learning Management System can do more than just send messages and reminder emails! Create home page alerts, add links to the home page, post banner images, and edit the home page welcome message.

Home Page Alerts

To add a homepage alerts, go to the **Admin tab --> Home Page Alerts** and then click the **plus button**

Select which user roles you want to be able to view the alert. The description field is a full rich text editor so you can add images, embed videos, add links, etc. If you want the alert to go away after a certain time, just set an expiration date.

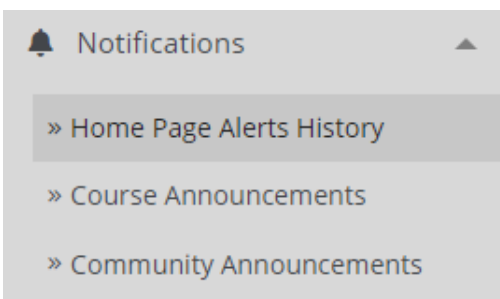

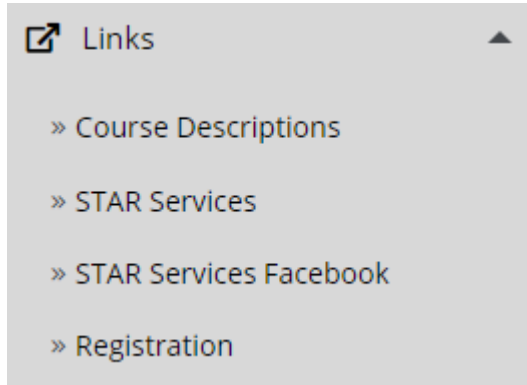
These alerts appear just under the Welcome Message on the home page, above the My Courses widget for students.

Users can mark these as “read” to dismiss them from the home page but past, dismissed notifications are still accessible from the left hand side of the home page under Home Page Alerts History.

Alerts can also be added on the course level! Navigate to the course and select "Course Alerts" at the bottom of the left hand menu.

Home Page Links


You can add external links directly to the home page of your LMS.



Links display on the left hand side of the home page.

This is particularly useful for Admins who use the LMS as their primary communication tool with staff.

To add links, go the **Admin tab --> Home Page Links** and then click the plus button
